Informational Meetings Scheduled for New Tech High School

In partnership with ACU, Abilene ISD will be creating a new high school that will incorporate the Project-Based Learning Model of the New Technology Foundation and the T-STEM initiative through the Texas High School Project. The New Tech High School will begin with approximately 100 ninth grade students chosen by a lottery from current 8th grade students in AISD and area schools.

The Director of NTHS@ACU, John M. Martinez, realizes there are many questions regarding New Tech that need to be answered such as, how will this be different from what the students are currently experiencing in school and how will this help them succeed at the next level of their education or in the job force? For this reason, he has put together a community forum that will take place at the Hunter Welcome Center on the campus of ACU and a series of TechTalk meetings that will take place at Mann and Madison Middle schools and One AISD Center.
