Bond Oversight Committee Minutes – Friday, December 11, 2020

The 2018 Bond Oversight Committee met Friday, December 11, 2020, at 12:00 p.m. at the New Taylor Elementary School facility.

Members present were Cary Etter, Seaton Higginbotham, Joe Humphrey, Danny Kittley, James Lemon, and Robert Puls. Also present were AISD Administrators Keith Dowell, Dr. Ketta Garduno, Scott McLean, Dr. Joseph Waldron, Rickey Wallace and Dr. David Young. Representatives from Sedalco were also present as well.

- I. Mr. McLean called the meeting to order at 12:07 p.m.
- II. The committee members received an overview of the Bond progress report that was presented by the architects to the Board of Trustees at the December regular board meeting.
 - A. Austin & Taylor Elementary The work at Austin Elementary has been completed. The work at Taylor Elementary should be completed and ready for the spring semester in January 2021.
 - B. High School Fine Arts The work to repurpose former CTE spaces at the high schools will begin once the Lift project has been completed to allow those spaces to be vacated. The plans for this project should be ready towards the end of this school year.
 - C. The Lift There was a brief period where the steel erection was stalled, but it has been progressing well. It should be noted that the progress on this project never stopped even with the pause in the steel erection because the contractor was able to continue work in other areas.
 - D. Dyess Elementary For the new Dyess Elementary School, several administrators have been working on a grant to make the Makerspace area and main library area very distinctive from Austin and Taylor.
- III. Financial Report Mr. Dowell stated that even though the work for Austin and the Multicampus Athletic projects has been completed we still have not been billed for the final pay application.
- IV. The committee was given a tour of the new Taylor Elementary School facility.



- Section 1 (Academic Wing) Steel work underway, primary structure to be complete before the end of the month.















Abilene High Band Relocation to CTE Building








Structural Steel Framing and Stage Floor








Gymnasium Face Brick, Interior Framing and Plumbing Rough-in


